


# **TOURIST GUIDE**

Ayubia is a beautiful place near Murree hill station. It has four small hill stations named known as Ghora Daka, Khanspur; Changla Gali and Khairagali. Ayubia is another cool place near Murree.Khairagali, Changlagali, Khanspur and Ghora Dhaka, these four mini resorts



spread over an area of 26 km have been developed into a resort complex called Ayubia. In addition to riding trails, hiking places and picnic spots, Ayubia has a chair lift, which like a skilift, takes you up to the summit of the nearby range for a panoramic view of the forested hills. Ayubia is 26 km from Murree.

Jhelum Valley (not to be confused with Jhelum city located in District Jhelum) is part of Azad Kashmir which is an excellent place to explore both for the local and international tourists. The long River Jhelum passes from the East side to the West between the beautiful lush green mountains of the valley. Apart from this some other worth visiting areas of the Jhelum Valley include the Chikar,



Peerchanasi, Chakothi, Leepa, Zilzaal Lake and the Ghari Dopatta.

Dunga Gali pipeline track follows the pipeline from Donga Gali to Ayubia, a distance of 4 kilometers, very easy walking track and takes 40 to 50 minutes having altitude around 8,200 ft. You are urged to capture unforgettable memories, natural beauty and charming weather enjoying



nature miracles like rain, sunshine, fog, and clouds in a single moment.

Pir Chinasi is a hill station located in Muzaffarabad District (Capital of Azad Kashmir). It is sighted 30 kilometers from Muzaffarabad and linked through a metal-topped road. Situated at a height of 2,895 meters (9,500 ft) above sea level, the sight presents its visitors with breathtaking views of nature's beauty. Due to its lush green plains, magnificent weather and charming lands

### Pir Chinasi

**Mushkpuri**s the second highest hill of Galyat. It is located in the Hills of Nathiagali in District Abbottabad, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Pakistan. There is a three hour long but safe hill trek to the top. It is approximately 9452 feet (2,800 meters) above sea level.

Mushkpuri to Dungagali down below there is a great sight of Ayubia National Park. There is a water pond at the Mushkpuri top, which gives beautiful reflection of trees and the sky. From Mushkpuri top Kashmir valley can also be

seen. There is a private **UES REST HOUSE** where you can get accommodation

Banjosa Lake is an artificial lake and a tourist resort 20 kilometers (12 mi) from the city of Rawalakot in District Poonch of Azad Kashmir, Pakistan. It is located at an altitude of 1,981 meters (6,499 ft).

The lake is surrounded by dense pine forest and mountains, which make it charming and romantic. The weather in the area remains cool in summers, and cold in winter. In December and January, snowfall also occurs here, and the temperature falls to -5 °C.

The Banjosa Lake is accessible by a metallic road from Rawalakot. Public transport vans run daily between Rawalakot and Banjosa.

Kutton (Also known as Jagran Valley) is a village and tourist resort in Neelam Valley, Azad Kashmir, Pakistan.

Kutton is accessible by Neelam road from Muzaffarabad branches off from Kundal Shahi.

Rest houses of AJK Tourism and Archeology Department and Water and

Power Development Authority (WAPDA) are located here. Some private rest houses and hotels are also available here for tourists stay.

Miranjani is the highest peak, at 2,992 meters (9,816 ft) in elevation, of Abbottabad District in the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Province of Pakistan. It is located in the Namli Maira area, in Ayubia National Park, 80 kilometers (50 mi) north of Islamabad in the western Himalayan range.

Miranjani is clad in Western Himalayan subalpine conifer

forests, with Pine, Walnut, Oak, and Maple trees and shrubs and herbs.


Naran is the most scenic location of Pakistan, situated in upper Kaghan valley in Mansehra district of KPK province. If you are travelling from Mansehra it is 119 kilometers away. You can take Naran road from Mansehra. Naran Valley is the base station that connects to the some of the attractive locations like Noori valley, Purbi Valley, Lake Saif ul Mulook, Lalazar, and Babusar Pass.



The tourist season in Naran Valley is from June to August. You can use public transport that runs on regular basis to reach Naran, although it becomes difficult to approach Naran in winters as the road leading to Naran is blocked due to excessive snowfall.

and Muzaffarabad city of Azad Kashmir, Pakistan. It is approximately 138 kilometres (86 mi) from Rawalpindi and Islamabad and about 76 kilometres (47 mi) from Abbottabad city.

The dam and the tunnel will be constructed on Kunhar River at Patrind Village in Muzaffarabad District, AJK and Abbottabad District on the right bank in Boi Village and the power house will on the right bank of Jhelum River in Muzaffarabad, AJK at lower Chattar.
